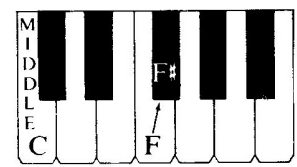
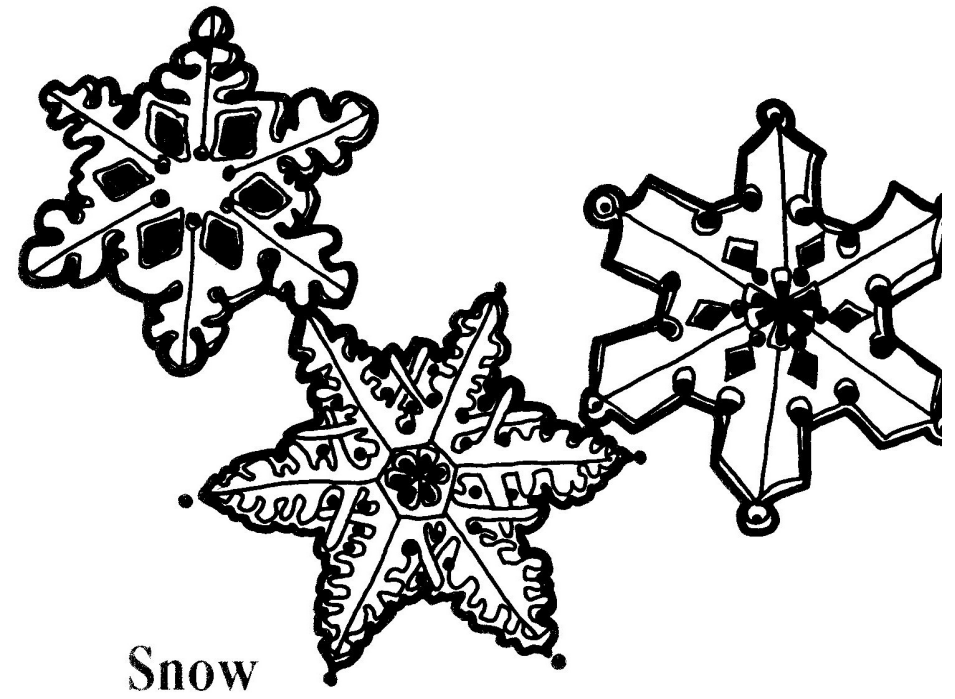


SHARP SIGN
